

Pension Application for Lemuel Allis

I Lemuel Allis of Plainfield in the County of Hampshire and County of Hampshire and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Testify and say that the first of February 1776. I inlisted as a soldier under Captain Israel Chapin in Colonel Chipson's Regiment in the Massachusetts Line & under General [blank] Thomas (who died at Chambly in an expedition to Canada; that I marched with said Company and Regiment to Quebeck, and returned to Albany & then with said Company. I removed to Morristown in Newjersey [New Jersey] at which place I was discharged in January 1777 having served out my time in the Continental Establishment Viz one year, I brought my discharge home with me, was soon after taken sick & was so deranged as to be confined & have never been able to find it since. [sic]

And I further say that I have received no pension from the Government, and from my reduced circumstances I am in need of assistance from my country for support. (Signed) Lemual Allis.
