

Pension Application for Hezekiah Baldwin

W.20656 (Widow: Abiel) Hezekiah died May 7, 1831.

From family record kept in an account book.

H.B. was born March 25th 1762.

Abial B. Born Nov 9th 1762.

Hezekiah Baldwin and Abial Curtise was married September 22d AD 1785.

Sylvester Baldwin was born November 5, 1786.

Calvin Baldwin was born May 21, 1788.

Huton Baldwin was Born March 16th 1790.

Philo Baldwin was born February 13th 1792.

Samual Baldwin was born February 17th 1794.

John Baldwin was born May 18th 1796.

David Baldwin was born April 8, 1801.

Hezekiah Baldwin 3d was born June 20th 1803.

Huldah Dawley died January 3rd 1829. Philo Baldwin died May 16th 1793.

Personally appeared before me Hobby Mead one of the Judges of the Common pleas of the County of Warren in the State of New York, Hezekiah Baldwin and deposed and says that he the said Hezekiah Baldwin enlisted for nine months in the army of the Revolution under the command of Capt. Funday in the Town of New Canaan in the County of Columby in the State of New York in the beginning of May in the year 1781 and marched to Albany and from there to Saratoga and there was attached to a company under the command of Capt. Silas Grey and remained under his command in Colonel Marinus Willet's Regiment until in December following when the army was going to winter quarters, then and there I took my discharge for my service which I lost the next summer in the Town of Kinderhook and have never seen it since and further this deponent saith not. (Signed) Hezekiah Baldwin

Subscribed and sworn this 26th day of April 1831 and I hereby certify that the said applicant is sick and unable to appear in open court to be examined and is confined to his bed. Hobby Mead, one of the Judges of the Court of Com. Pleas of Warren County.

Letter in folder dated December 7, 1923, written in reply to a request for information.

I have to inform you that from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim W.20656, it appears that Hezekiah Baldwin was born March 25, 1762. He enlisted at New Canaan, Columbia County, New York, in May 1781 and served eight months and twenty-five days as a private in Captains Fonda and Silas Gray's Companies, Colonel Marinus Willett's New York Regiment.

He married in New Canaan, Columbia County, New York, September 22, 1784 or '85, Abiel Curtis (or Curtise) born November 9, 1762. He died May 7, 1831 in Chester, Warren County, New York, and she was allowed pension on her application executed August 18, 1843, while living in Marion, Wayne County, New York.
