Barnes, David. His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of Connecticut, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on July 21, 1795 and printed in the American State Papers, Class 9, page 153.

Rank: Private

Regt: Col. Livingston's

Disability: Lost his right eye, occasioned by the bursting of a musket belonging to a soldier who stood at his right hand as he fired at the enemy.

When and where disabled: 1777, Behmus's Heights.

Residence: Cheshire.

To what pension entitled: One-half.

Remarks: Enlisted Jan. 1, 1777, for the war; on the rolls in 1781.

Evidence complete, excepting that his disability from known wounds is not proved.
