

### **Pension Application for Levi Bishop**

W.25239 (Widow: Nancy) Married August 9, 1789. Levi died February 8, 1849.  
B/L.Wt.6876-100 No papers.

Letter in folder dated February 20, 1926, written in response to an inquiry.

I have to advise you from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim, W.25239, it appears that Levi Bishop was born December 9, 1760, place not stated.

He enlisted (date not given) for and during the war and continued until discharged June 9, 1783, at which time he was a private in Captain Gershom Mott's Company, Colonel Lamb's Second Regiment of Continental Artillery.

He was allowed pension on his application executed September 9, 1828, while a resident of Manlius, Onondaga County, New York. He died February 8, 1849.

Soldier married August 9, 1789 in Dutchess County, New York, Nancy Hunt, born February 27, 1764. She was allowed pension on her application executed June 12, 1849, while a resident of Manlius, New York. She died Dec 29, 1852.
