For the purpose of obtaining the benefit of "An act for the relief of certain surviving officers and soldiers of the Army of the Revolution, approved on the 15<sup>th</sup> May 1828, I Amable Boileau of Champlain in the County of Clinton in the State of ;New York do hereby declare that I enlisted in the Continental line of the Army of the Revolution for & during the war and continued in its service until its termination; at which period I was a private in Captain's Satterly's Company in Col hazen's regiment of the New York line.

And I also declare that I afterwards received a certificate for the reward of eighty dollars to which I was entitled under a resolve of congress passed the 15<sup>th</sup> of May 1778.

And I further declare that I was not on the fifteenth day of March 1828 on the pension list of the United States. (Signed with his mark) Amable Boileau
