

**Pension Application for Hendrick Bonta or Henry Banta**

W.24704 (Widow Engeltje or Angelica) Married In the Reformed Dutch Church of Schenectada, June 3, 1787, Eneltje Schermerhorn. F Enlisted in Half Moon in the militia commanded by Capt. Thomas Hicks, Colonel Jacobus VanSchoonhoven.

On this eleventh day of April 1793 personally appeared before the subscriber one of the Justices of the Peace in and for said County Angelica Bonta a resident of the town of perch in said county, aged seventy five years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefits of the provision made by the Act of Congress passed on the 3d of March 1893, granting pension to widows of persons who served during the Revolutionary War.

That she is the widow of Henry Banta who was a Lieutenant in the war of the revolution & served in manner & for the terms set forth in her papers in the matter of her application for a pension under the act of Congress passed 7<sup>th</sup> July 1738. That she received under said act a pension of \$252 per annum.

And she further declares that she is still his widow. (Signed with her mark) Anjelica Banta.

Subscribed and sworn this 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 1843 before me, and I certify that said Angelica Banta is to me personally known. John F. Knox J.P.
