Adam Brannon of the Town of Owasco & County aforesaid being duly sworn saith that in the year seventeen hundred & seventy seven in Fort Montgomery he enlisted as a private soldier in Captain Thomas Lee's Company in Colonel Dubois Regiment being the fifth Regiment in General Clinton's Brigade in the New York Line for & during three years & that he served out the said term & was then honorably discharged from the same Regiment & from Captain Henry Dubois Company—near Morristown in the State of New Jersey and that his discharge was burnt up in his house.

And he further saith that by reason of his reduced circumstances he is in need of assistance from his Country for Support. (Signed with his mark) Adam Bronnan
