

Disability for Phineas Cox

Cox, Phineas

His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page. 92.

Rank: Private.

Disability: Ruptured in stretching a chain across the North River.

When and where disabled: October 1776, Fort Montgomery.

Residence: Minisink.

Remarks: Not found on the musters of the N. York line. (1)

Evidence transmitted by the District Court incomplete.

No examination of surgeons. No evidence of his leaving the service.
