

Disability for Henry Crawford

Crawford, Henry

His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the district Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page 95.

Rank: Dragoon.

Regt: Col. Sheldon's.

Disability: Wounded by a musket ball in the thigh in an action with the enemy.

When and where disabled: November, 1777, mile square.

Residence: Washington County.

Remarks: Enlisted May 7, 1777; discharged November 15, 1780.
