Pension Application for Prince Danford

On the 28th day of March 1818—before me the Subscriber, first Judge of the county of Orange personally appears Prince Danford aged about 63 years, resident in the Town of New Windsor, in said County – who being by me first duly sworn according to law—do thereon his oath make. The following declaration in order to obtain the Provision namely the late act of congress, entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged, in the Land and Navil [Naval] Service of the United States in the Revolutionary War.—that he the said Prince Danford, entered in the year 1777 in Orange County in the company commanded by Captain Godwin—in the 5th New York Regiment commanded by Colonel Lewis DuBois—and that he continued to serve in the said regiment until it was reduced in 1780 and then he served in the 2d New York Regiment commanded by Colonel P. Countlandt—until the year 1783 when he was discharged by General Washington, and that his discharge is hereunto annexed.
