

**Pension Application for Amos Denton**

On this 4<sup>th</sup> day of October 1820 personally appeared in open court being a court of Common Pleas, (and court of record) being a court of record because it proceeds according to the course of Common Law within Jurisdiction non-limited in point of amount keeping a record of its proceedings, holden in and for the County of Seneca, State and District of New York, Amos Denton aged fifty nine years resident in the Town of Galen, County of Seneca and State of New York, who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath declare that he served in the Revolutionary War—as follows to wit:

In the company commanded by Capt. John Johnson in the Regiment commanded by Col. Lewis Dubois in the New York Line and that he has received a pension from the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 1818 and that the number of his certificate is (15107), and I do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the Unitedent [sic] citizen of United States on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift sale or in any manner disposed of my property or any part thereof with intent there by so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress entitled an act to provide to certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War passed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1818 and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or securities contracts or debts due to me nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed and by me subscribed and I further state that I am a farmer by occupation and that I am not able to labor but a very small part of the time I have no family but myself. (Signed) Amos Denton
