

Pension Application for Hugh Deyo or Doro

W.20963 (Widow: Catharine) Hugh died the last day of February 1828. There doesn't seem to be any deposition showing Hugh's service.

Catharine Deyo of the Town of Schodack in said County being duly sworn says, that she is the same person who has applied for a pension as the widow of Hugh Deyo, deceased, who was a soldier in the war of the Revolution. That the maiden name of this deponent (before her marriage with the said Hugh Deyo) was Ter Boss, and frequently pronounced TerBush TerBoss, and which afterward, became in common parlance "Bush" and which was the same scheduled name now pronounced & called "Bush" and so [?] & used by the descendant of the family.

That this deponent resided at the time of her marriage in "Paltz" Ulster County & State of New York, as said town was formerly generally known & now called "New Paltz".

And this deponent further says, that the following are the names of her children. Jacob who died in [?], Daniel Deyo (who no wresides in Schodack, Betsy or Elizabeth Henry (who resides in Long Island) Henry TenBush sayd—Susan Deyo both of whom reside in Schodack and David Deyo, who resides in the City of Albany. And further this deponent saith not. (Signed with her mark) Catharine Deyo
