

**Pension Application for Michael Dufan or Dufau**

For the purpose of obtaining the benefits of an act entitled "An act for the relief of certain surviving officers and soldiers of the Army of the Revolution, approved on the 15<sup>th</sup> of May 1828 I Michael Dufan of Champlain in the County of Clinton in the state of New York do hereby declare, that I enlisted in the Continental Line of the Army of the Revolution for and during the war & continued in its service until its termination; at which service I was a private in Captain Goslin's Company in General Hazens Regiment of the New York Line.

And I also declare that I afterwards received certificate for the reward of eighty dollars; to which I was entitled under a resolve of Congress, passed the 15<sup>th</sup> of May 1778.

And I further declare, that I was not on the fifteenth day of May 1828, on the pension list of the Untied States.
