Letter in folder dated April 15, 1920, written in response to an inquiry.

In reply to your letter of the e27th ultimo, you are advised that in the report of the Secretary of War in relationship to the pension establishment of the United States, which was printed in 1835, on the list of invalid pensioners who had been inscribed on the roll of the New York Agency, and whose residence and other information in regard to them, could not be ascertained in consequence of the destruction of the War Office by fire in 1800 and again in 1814, appears the name William Elbertson, a private for the Army of the Revolution, annual allowance \$60. There is not further data on file relative to him.
