

Pension Application for Samuel Evans

Rhoda Hill being duly sworn according to law on her oath says that she resides in Wheatfield in the County of Niagara in this state, and that she is a daughter of Samuel Evans Jun'r deceased, who was a Revolutionary soldier and as the deponent has always understood and believes, that he was a [sic] during war soldier and served until peace was made between this country and Great Britain.

The deponent believes that her Father made application for a pension a short time before his death but which pension, as the deponent believes was never allowed, that her father died in the town of Cicero in the County of Onondaga in this state on the 14th day of August AD 1832.

This affidavit is made in order to ascertain if the application above mentioned is on file. What service was claimed to have been performed, and what further proof will be required to obtain the same by the heirs, I wish a full report made to Samuel Lake Buffalo, NY.
