On this 17th Day of March one thousand eight hundred and fifty two personally appeared before me James B. Houghtaling a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid Simon Fort aged 65 years a resident of Troy Albany County State of New York who being duly sworn according to Law Declares that he is son and heir at law of Nicholas Fort of Late a Soldier and teamster in the Revolutionary Army and I Simon Fort verily Believes his father Nicholas Fort Deceased served in the Campain [Campaign] on the Mohawk River in the war with Great Britian [Britain] and Died on or about 14 Day of February 1833 and now his widow never had Drawn any Bounty Land nor Pension Money for his services in the United States Army. He makes this Declaration for the Purpose of obtaining his Bounty Land and Pension money promised to Certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the military services of the United States Army under act of Congress Passed the 7th Day of June 1832.
