

Bounty Land for Henry Godwin

B.L.Wt.829-300-Capt.

Issued Aug 19, 1790 to Cateline Godwin, Executrix.

This information was in a letter to the War Office requesting information on Abraham and Henry Godwin. The writer listed Callina Banta as Henry's widow and that stated she drew a pension, which can't be verified. Father of Helene Godwin, born March 20, 1775, Married John DeVoe Jan 26, 1791, died January 30, 1866.

March 29, 1927, letter in folder, written in reply to the above inquiry.

I have to advise you that this bureau is unable to furnish the history of a soldier of the Revolution unless a claim for pension or bounty land has been made on account of his service, and a careful search of the records fails to show such a claim on file on account of the service of Abraham DeVoe.

Henry Godwin, Captain of the New York Line, War of the Revolution, Bounty Land Warrant #829, for three hundred acres, issued August 19, 1790 to Catelina Godwin, executrix.
