

**Pension Application for Daniel Hammond**

On this second day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Thirty two personally appeared in open court before the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas in and for the said County of Suffolk Daniel Hammond a resident of the Town of Brookhaven in said County and State aged eighty years who being duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress passed June 7<sup>th</sup> 1832.

That he entered or enlisted in the Army of the United States in the year seventeen hundred and seventy six—in the New York Line under the following named officers—Daniel Griffing Captain—Nathaniel Norton Second Lieutenant—and James Clinton Colonel.

That he enlisted in said company at Coram in the said Town of Brookhaven in the first part of the Month of May for the term of one year—

That he continued to serve in said company until the expiration of said term when he was regularly discharged at Southold in said County.

That he enlisted afterwards in the month of June in the Company by Daniel Roe. That Nathaniel Norton was also Lieutenant in said company but whether he was first or second Lieutenant this deponent does not recollect.

That he enlisted for the term of nine months. That he continued to serve until the expiration of said term when he was discharged by General Schuyler together with the whole company who returned to their homes as they pleased.

That he returned to his home at Brookhaven at which place he resided when he entered the said company.

That he was discharged at Albany in the said State of New York.

That he was in no engagement or battle.

That he never had a written discharge.

That he was a volunteer.

That he has no documentary evidence in his possession respecting his service and that he knows of no person whose testimony he can procure who can testify to the same.

That he hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present and declares that his name is not on the pension roll of the agency or any state. (Signed) Daniel Hammond.
