Pension Application for Samuel Hatch

R.4737 (Widow: Elizabeth) Samuel died August 16, 1828. Elizabeth died July 1, 1848. Eight children: Calvin, Philip, Daniel, Ira, Samuel Hatch. Cynthia Parker, Lovina Hunt & Eliza Hunt. It doesn't appear as if Samuel applied for a pension, there is no deposition in the file for him.

There is a letter in the folder dated July 25, 1919, written in response to an inquiry.

In response to your letter dated the 11th instant, you are advised that in the Revolutionary War pension claim R. File No. 4,737 it is alleged that Samuel Hatch was born July 5, 1764, in the state of New York and resided during the Revolution and several years subsequent thereto at Hillsdale Columbia County, New York and towards the close of the Revolution enlisted in the New York Troops and served more than two years.

He married September 21, 1785, at Hillsdale, N.Y. Elizabeth Reed who was born January 31, 1766. He died August 16, 1828. She died July 1, 1844. Their children were:

Daniel born August 6, 1788, mar. February 2, 1809.

Cintha born May 27, 1791, mar. February 19, 1808.

Elijah born August 27, 1794, died March 30, 1810.

William born October 25, 1796, died May 17, 1814.

Lovina born April 4, 1801, mar. November 18, 1824.

Calvin born July 7, 1803, May 10, 1826.

Samuel born September 7, 1805, Mar. November 30, 1826.

Eliza born January 19, 1808, mar. January 19, 1827.

Elizar born May 12, 1810, died February 1811.

Calvin, Philip, Daniel, Ira, Samuel, Cintha Parker, Lovina Hunt and Eliza Hunt survived their parents.

February 12, 1848 son Calvin applied for pension that might have been due the heirs of Elizabeth Hatch on an application executed February 12, 1849, while a resident of Randolph, Crawford County, Pennsylvania. The claim was rejected owing to lack of proof or service.
