

Disability for John Hawgerdon

Hawgerdon, John

His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the district of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page 95.

Rank: Private

Regt: Col. Vrooman's

Disability: Wounded by a musket ball in the left hip, but not much injured.

When and where disabled: June 10, 1780, near Delaware.

Residence: Otsego County

Remarks: There are no militia rolls in this office.

Evidence transmitted by the District Court incomplete. Viz: As to a continuance of disability for two years after he left the service. Physicians are of opinion the wounds are of little consequence.
