On this twelvth [twelfth] day of February AD 1849 personally appeared in open court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid, now in Session Daniel Herrick a resident of Mead Township Crawford Courts aforesaid aged eighty two years who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress passed June 7, 1832.

The he was employed in the erection of a certain Fort in Warren Bush now called the (Town of Florida) Montgomery County State of New York on the firs of March 1781 and continued to work at said Fort until the last of April following at which time the Fort was completed.

Declarant further avers that he was continued in service & garrisoned at said Fort from the last of April aforesaid until the last of November following at which time he was discharged. During the erection of the Fort as aforesaid he served under Capt. Stephen White in the regiment commanded by Lieut Col. Marinus Willet.—and while garrisoned at the Fort he served under Lieut John Thornton of the Regiment aforesaid at and previous to the declarants entering the service he was a resident of Montgomery County afsd.

That he was never in an actual engagement—

That he hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present—

He further declares that his name is not on the pension roll of any agency in any state or territory. (Signed) D. Herrick
