

**Bounty Land Information for Ebenezer Hutchinson**

B.L.Wt.1022-300 Surg. Mate. Issued Dec 22, 1791 to William H. Cook Admin. Also records as above under B.L.Wt 2598.

Letter in folder dated December 30, 1932, written in response to an inquiry.

Reference is made to your letter in which you request information in regard to Ebenezer Hutchison, a soldier of the War of the Revolution.

Revolutionary War data furnished by this office are obtained from claims made to the United States for pension and bounty land based upon the military service of soldiers in that war.

You are furnished herewith the record of the only soldier by that name that is found on file in the Revolutionary War records of this office.

Warrant No. 1022 for three hundred acres of bounty land was issued December 22, 1791 to William H. Cook, administrator, on account of the services of Surgeon's Mate Ebenezer Hutchinson of the New York Line, War of the Revolution.

There is no further information relative to his service nor no data as to his family, due to the destruction of papers in such claims, when the War Office was burned.
