

Pension Application for Philip Knickerbocker

R.6020 (Widow: Hannah) Married Hannah Harder July 5, 1806, Town of Gallatin, County of Columbia, New York by Rev. Herman Vedder. Philip died in the year 1827.

There is no deposition in this file giving the service record for Philip Knickerbocker. The letter in the folder dated July 6, 1926 was written in response to a request for information.

I have to advise you, that from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim, R.6020, it appears that Philip Knickerbocker married July 5, 1806, at Gallatin, Columbia County, New York, Hannah Harder and he died in Columbia County, New York in 1826 or 1827.

On August 20, 1852, while living in Madison County, New York, aged eighty years, the widow Hannah applied for pension and alleged that her husband entered the service during the Revolution, but her claim was not allowed as she failed to furnish proof of his services.
