

**Pension Application for Abraham Low**

I Abraham Low of Guilderland formerly of Kingston in Ulster County, the same who on the 18<sup>th</sup> of September 1832 subscribed and made oath to a declaration to obtain a pension, do now declare that the following additional facts to be true to wit:

That I was born in the Town of Kingston in Ulster County on the 25<sup>th</sup> March 1758, and that the record thereof can be seen, by a reference to the Dutch Church Books at Kingston, and to the family Bible belonging to this declares father's family and which is now in the possession of this declarer's niece, who is the widow of Xachariah Schoonmaker deceased now of Kingstton aforesaid.

That the Declarer for the purpose of rendering his claim for a pension more clear and distinct than it is in his said first declaration above refered to, doth now in the most Solemn manner declare and swear, that he enlisted as a private in Capt. Moses Cantine's Company in Colo Albert Paulings Reft of Militia, and served without intermission from the First of July 1776 until the last of November in the year 1777 exclusive of the several short tours of militia duty which this declarer has performed subsequent to the said year 1777 of which this declarer makes no account of in his declaration.
