

**Pension Application for Simeon or Simion Marshal**

County of Saratoga SS.

On this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August 1820? personally appeared in open Court, in the Court of Common Pleas of the said County, the same being a Court of Record for said County, proceeding according to the course of the common law with a jurisdiction unlimited in point of amount, keeping a record of its proceedings and having the power of fine and imprisonment, Simeon Marshal aged sixty four years resident in the County, in the State aforesaid, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth, on his oath, declare that he served in the Revolutionary War as follows:

I served at Crown Point six months in Capt. Marvin's Company, Benedict Arnold commanding officer served about ten months in Col. VanSchaick's regiment, New York line, was discharged the first time at Saratoga and the second time in Albany.

That his original declaration was made on or about the month of May 1818 and that is Pension Certificate is numbered 15.385.

And I solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1818; and that I have not since that time, by gift, sale, or in any manner, disposed of my property, or any part thereof, with intent thereby so to diminish it, as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress, entitled" an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States, in the Revolutionary war," passed on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1818; and that I have not, nor has any person in trust for me, any property or securities, contracts of debts, due to me; nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed, and by me subscribed.

And if further declare That I have no family and wholly unable to work, no particular infirmity, old age and the consequent debility is the cause of my inability to labour. (Signed with his mark) Simion Marshall
