The first one died in infancy—deponent further says that she cannot produce better testimony of her marriage than the record hereunto attached taken from the family Bible—all those who were present at the marriage of deponent & James Montgomery are dead—deponent further says that the Clergyman who married her to James Montgomery is also dead and no records to be found—the reason this deponent makes this affidavit is that her children are all dead except her daughter Jane who resides in Allegeny County & State aforesaid—deponents Husband never apply'd for a Pension—the reason was that the deponent's husband had a small farm and further this deponent saith not.
