David Morine being duly sworn deposes and saith that he is a Resident Citizen of the town of Cincinnatus in said County of Cortland and that this deponent in the year seventeen hundred and seventy six Enlisted into the continental Army into the company commanded by William Jackson which company belonged to a Regiment commanded by Col. Henry Livingston in the York line for one year, and served his term out faithfully and obtained an honorable discharge from the same, but the discharge was not in writing.

Afterwards about a month after said discharge and in the year seventeen hundred and seventy seven the deponent enlisted into a company commanded by Andrew Rickey belonging to the aforesaid Regiment commanded by Col. Henry Livingston for the term of three years and served faithfully during the whole of said three years and was then Honorably discharged from the service by a Major Shutiff who belonged to the said Regiment but his discharge was not in writing.
