

Bounty Land for William Morrell

B.L.Wt.7603-100-PVT.

Issued July 15, 1790 to John Hathorn, assignee. No papers.

In reply to your letter of the 13th instant, you are advised that a careful search of the records fails to show a claim for pension filed on account of the services of any Wailliam Morrell who served in the New York Troops, War of the Revolution, or who resided in that state.

On July 15, 1790, Warrant No. 503 for 100 acres of bounty land was issued to John Hathorn, assignee, on account of the services of William Morrell, Private, New York Troops, Revolutionary War. There is not further data on file relative to this soldier, the papers in said claim were destroyed when the War Office was burned in November, 1800.
