

Pension Application for Conrad Mower

On this fifteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty three, in open court before the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas now sitting in the court house in & for said county, personally appeared, Coonrad Mowers named in the declaration hereto annexed, who first being duly sworn deposes & says in addition to and explanations [explanations] of his said former declaration, that all the services which he rendered in the Revolutionary War & mentioned in his said former declaration, were rendered by him as a private soldier.

That the services mentioned in his former declaration as having been rendered in the winter of 1777, commenced according to his best knowledge recollection & belief in December 1776 ended in the latter part of March 1777—and during that turn of service this Deponent service in a company commanded by Capt. Samuel Pitting & not under Capt. Blevins as mentioned in his former declaration, and Frederick Sammons & William Wallace served with deponent.

That according to his best recollection & belief he was in the service at least seven days in the month of August 1777. While under the command of Lieutenant Joseph Printup as mentioned in his former declaration.

That the time he enlisted for nine months into the company commanded by Capt. Gerrit Putman as mentioned in his former declaration was in the month of March 1778 & he served till the latter part of December in that year according to his best recollection & belief & he well remembers that when he & the others in the company were discharged, the said captain said to them “Boys you have served out your time & you can go home” & this deponent well remembers that when he was so discharged the winter was cold & there was good sleighing. That that [sic] this deponent is unable to state the periods for which he served more particularly.
