

Pension Application for Isaac Nostrant or VanNostrant

R.10881 (Widow: Mary or Polly)

On this Eleventh day of Decr 1821, personally appeared in open Court of Common Pleas in and for said County, being a Court of Record, Isaac Nostrant alias VanNostrant, aged 61 years, resident in Boonville in said County, who, being first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath declare he served in the Revolutionary War as follows: He enlisted in the year 1776 in C

That Capt VanBenschoten's Company Colo Gansevoort's Regt, Genl Clinton's Brigade for three years and served out his time and was regularly discharged at Morristown.

That he is by occupation a Farmer but without a farm and owing to infirmities is unable to support himself.

That the number and names of his family residing with him; their ages and capacity to contribute to their support is as follows, viz.

His wife Polly aged 55 years in bad health for many years past and unable to support himself.

His son Peter twelve years old.

And I do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the Unites States, on the eighteenth day of March, one thousand eighth hundred and eighteen, and that I have not since that time, by gift, sale, or in any manner whatever, disposed of my property, or any part thereof, with intent thereby with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress entitled "an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War", passed on; the eighteenth day of March one thousand eight hundred and eighteen and that I have not, nor has any person in trust for me, any property or securities, contracts, or debts, due to me; nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed and by me subscribed.
