

Pension Application for Charles Parsons

B.L.Wt.1680-300 Capt.

Issued Dec 15, 1790. No papers.

Letter in folder dated January 24, 1921, written in response to an inquiry.

In response to your letter dated December 15, 1920, you are advised that from the records of this Bureau it appears that Charles Parsons, a Captain of the New York Line, War of the Revolution, was allowed 300 acres of bounty land on warrant No. 1680, which issued December 15, 1790.

There is not further information on file as to his services, and no data as to his family, owing to the destruction of papers in such claims when the War Office was burned in November 1800.

It does not appear that a claim for pension was made on account of his services.
