I, Pierre Pyon aged seventy seven years, do, upon oath, testify and declare, that, in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy six I enlisted for the term of "*during the war,*" and served in the regiment No. [blank] under the command of Colonel James Livingston of the New York line; and that I continued in the service aforesaid until the close of the war, when I was regularly discharged from the Congress regiment, commanded by Colonel Moses Hazen.

I further declare, that I have never received a warrant for the *Bounty Land* promised to me on the part of the United States; nor have I ever assigned or transferred my claim in any manner whatsoever: therefore, KNOW all men by these presents, that I Pierre Pyon aforesaid, do hereby constitute and appoint Col. Joseph Watson of Washington City to be my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name to demand and receive from the Secretary of War of the United State, *a warrant* for the quantity of Land due to me as aforesaid; and my said attorney is hereby fully authorized and empowered to constitute and appoint one or more substitutes for attorneys under him; for the special purposes above expressed.
