On this thirtieth day of May 1818 before me the subscriber one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas of Ulster County personally appears Jacob Quick aged 58 years resident in New Paltz in said County of Ulster who being by me first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain he provision made by the late act of Congress entitled "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the Land and naval Service of the United States, in the revolutionary war."

The he the Jacob Quick enlisted in Rochester in the state of New York in the year 1778 for during the war in the Company commanded by Captain [blank] French second New York or Cortlandt's Regiment that he continued to serve in the said corps or in the service of the United States until the close of war when he was discharged in Orange County in the State of New York, that he was in the Battles at [the] taking of Cornwallis & in a skirmish at Paramus in New Jersey and that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of the assistance of his country for support and that he has no other evidence now in his power of his said services.
