

Pension Application for John Rhoads

For the purpose of obtaining the benefit of "An act for the relief or certain surviving officers and soldiers of the army of the Revolution" approved on the 15th of May 1838. I John Rhoads of the Town of Marlborough in the County of Ulster in the State of New York, do hereby declare that I enlisted in the continental line of the army of the Revolution for and during the war, and continued in its service until its termination, at which period I was a private in Captain Amos Hutchins Company in the fifth Regiment of the New York line.

And I do also declare that I afterwards received a certificate for the reward of eighty dollars to which I was entitled under a resolve of Congress passed the 15th of May 1778.

And I further declare that I was not on the fifteenth day of March 1828, on the pension list of the United States. (Signed) John Rhoads.
