

Pension Application for Samuel Rogers

Ctf. No. 30696 An hand written note states that no deposition by Samuel Rogers is in the file.

Letter in folder dated December 26, 1929, written in response to an inquiry.

I advise you from the records of this bureau, it appears that Samuel Rogers was pensioned for his services in the War of the Revolution on Certificate No. 30696, which was issued June 15, 1836, at the rate of \$56.66 per annum.

His pension commenced March 4, 1831 and he was paid at the New York agency.

He died December 14, 1841 in Duanesburg, Schenectady, County, New York. Leaving a widow, Lydia Rogers and a son Daniel Rogers of Little Falls, Herkimer County, New York.
