William Rose was born in Hesse Cassel Germany Sept. 14th 1738

Elizabeth Schoolcraft was born in Schoharrie New York U.S.A. Dec 25th 1738.

William Rose married to Elizabeth Schoolcraft in Schoharrie N.Y. 1760.

Jacob Rose, son of William Rose was born in Schoharrie N.Y. April 21, 1761.

Silas Bowker was born in Massachusetts April 15th 1739.

Esther Hobbs was born in Weston Massachusetts April 24th 1739.

Silas Bowker was married to Esther Hobbs in Weston Mass. March 1761.

Lisa Bowker was born in Willington Tolland County Conn. June 15th 1765.

Jacob Rose married to Lisa Bowker at Marbletown Ulster County N.Y. Aug 5th 1784.

William Rose, son of Jacob Rose, was born at Marbletown Ulster County N.Y. on Wednesday the 27th April 1785.

Cynthia Rose was born at Colchester Delaware County, N.Y. on Sunday 9th July 1786.

Jerusha Rose was born at Colchester Delaware County N.Y. on Monday 25th February 1788.

Isaac Rose was born at Chenango County of Tioga (now Broome) N.Y. on Wednesday 31st March 1790.

Samuel Hobbs Rose was born at Chenango, Tioga, (now Broome) County N.Y. on Monday the 5th day of March 1792.

Silas Rose was born at Chenango, Tioga (now Broome) County, on Tuesday 2nd Sept. 1794.

John Rose was born in Locke Cayuga County N.Y. on Monday 24th October, 1796.

Matthew Rose was born in Locke Cayuga County N.Y. on Sunday 22nd July 1798.

Sarah Rose was born in Locke, Cayuga County, N.Y. on Sundy [Sunday] 30th march 1800.

Matthew, son of Jacob rose died at Groton Tompkins County N.Y. after an illness of three years, July 17th 1822 in the 24th year of his age. Sermon from Job 22nd Chapt 21 verse, by Elder E. W. Martin.

Sarah Rose was married to John Miller at Groton Tompkins County N.Y. 17th oct. 1822 and died in the same place July 28th 1825 in the 25th year of her age.

Lovina her daughter was born in Sempronius Cayuga County Sept. 1823 & died at Groton Tompkins County 3 Nov. 1824. Discourse by E. W. Martin Sermon at funeral of Sarah by Elder T. Beebe from Luke 12 Chap 40 Verse. Sally Lovina her daughter was born in Sempronius Cayuga County May 6, 1825, Died in Groton Tompkins County 11th July 1825.

Silas Bowker died at Chenango Tioga (now Broome) County N.Y. 15th October 1789, in the 51st year of his age.

Esther wife of Silas Bowker, Died in Lansing Tompkins County N.Y. 27th March 1824. Discourse by Elder Wall from Proverbs 14th Chap. 32nd Verse. Sermon at funeral of Silas Bowker by Elder Timothy Howe from Matthew 24 Capt 44 verse.

Silas Rose was born at Chenango, Tioga (now Broome) Co., N.Y. on Tuesday Sept. 2, 1794.

John Rose was born at Locke (now Groton) Cayuga, (Now Tompkins) Co., N.Y. on Monday, 24th Oct. 1796.

Matthew H. Rose was born in Locke (now Groton) Cayuga, (now Tompkins) Co., N.Y. on Sunday 22d July 1798.

Sarah Rose was born in Locke (now Groton) Cauyga, l(now Tompkins) Co., N.Y. on Sunday 30th March 1800.

State of New York

Tompkins County SS.

On this 3rd day of June In the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty eight before me the subscriber, one of the Justices of the peace in and for the said County of Tompkins in said State, personally appears Jacob Rose aged sixty seven years resident in the Town of Groton in the said County of Tompkins, and State of New York, who being by me first duly sworn according to law, doth, on his oath, make the following declaration, in order to obtain the pension [pension] granted by Congress by an act of Congress, intituled [entitled] and act for the Relief of Certain Surviving officers and soldiers of the army of the Revolution, passed the Senate April 29th 1828.

That he the said Jacob Rose enlisted in the Town of Rotchester [Rochester] in the County of Ulster In the State of New York in the company commanded by Captain Jonathan Hallet—in Colonel VanCortland's Redgiment [Regiment] in the latter part of the year seventeen hundred and seventy eight, in the Continental line (for the term of) for and during the war, and that he the said Jacob Pose continued in the said Rigement [Regiment] in the service of the United States, until its termination, and thereby became entitled to receive a reward of eighty dollars under a resolve of Congress, passed May fifteen seventeen hundred and seventy eight, and that he the said Jacob Rose was discharged at Snack Hill [Snake Hill] in the State of New York.

After the war ended in the year seventeen hundred and eighty three. And further the s'd Jacob Rose doth testify that he is the same Jacob Ross, that has been on the pension list of the United States a short time, under an act of congress entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the Land and Naval service fothe United States in the Revolutionary war; which pension was stopt by an amendment to this s'd act and that he the s'd Rose applied again to have his pension reversed, and lost his old certificate was sent to the war department with his application which he expects is there on file. (Signed) Jacob Rose

Sworn to and declares before me the day and year first aforesaid. Benjamin Williams, Justice of the peace.

Letter in folder dated June 28, 1920, written in response to an inquiry.

In reply to your letter of the 27th ultimo, you are advised that from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim, Widow File No., 4578, it appears, that Jacob Rose was born in Schoharie, New York, April 21, 1761. He enlisted at Rochester, New York, in November 1778, as Private in Jonathan Hallet's Company, Colonel Philip VanCortland's Regiment, New York Line, and was in the battle at Newtown and at the siege of York, and was discharged in June 1783. He was allowed pension on his application executed November 27, 1818, while living in Groton, Tompkins County, New York.

Soldier married at Marbletown, Ulster County, New York, August 5, 1784, Lisa Bowker, who was born in Willington, Connecticut, June 15, 1765. He died in Delaware County, Ohio, August 20, 1839, and she was allowed pension on her application executed August 15, 1843 while a resident of Trenton Township, Delaware County, Ohio.

Soldier's father William Rose was born in Hesse Cassel, Germany, September 14, 1738 and died at Colchester, Delaware County, New York, April 25, 1819. He married at Schoharie, New York, in 1760, Elizabeth Schoolcraft, she was born in Schoharie, December 25, 1738 and died at Chenango, New York, March 11, 1822.
