

Pension Application for Benjamin Terry

On this 18th day of July 1832 before the subscriber one of the Associate Judges of the Court of Common Pleas and Quarter Session &c personally John Horton of the said County who being sworn according to Law doth declare and say that in Orange County in the State of New York he enlisted in a Company commanded by Captain Delavan in the regiment commanded by Col. Malcom in the month of August 1780.

In that at the same time and place Benjamin Terry enlisted in the same company for three months and served out his term of time & was dismissed at Albany. And again in the month of April 1782 the said Benjamin Terry enlisted in a company commanded by Captain Simon Westfall in the Regiment commanded by Col. Pauling for eight months & served the term of time at and about Penpack in the State of New York. (Signed) John Horton.
