

Pension Application for William Tompkins

For the purpose of obtaining the benefit of the act entitled an act for the relief or certain surviving officers and soldiers of the Army of the Revolution, approved the 15th of May 1828.

I William Tompkins of Phillipstown in the County of Putnam and State of New York do hereby declare that I enlisted in the Continental line of the Army of the revolution for & during the war & continued in its service until its termination, when I was discharged at Fishkill in the State of New York, I also declare that I enlisted as aforesaid in Fishkill aforesaid under Major John Keys in the fall of the year, between three & four years before the close of the war, that immediately after my enlistment I was assigned to Col. Hays department, where I served during the whole time as a waggoner that I was at the Capture of Cornwallis at Yorktown & drove Genl Knox's baggage waggoner on that occasion.

I also declare that I was not on the 15th day of May 1828 on the pension list of the United States. (Signed with his mark) Wm. Tompkins.
