

### **Pension Application for Joseph VanDeBogart**

W.15968 (Widow) Rachel married to Joseph July 1778. Joseph died January 13, 1814.

Letter in folder dated May 14, 1929, written in response to an inquiry.

I advise you from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim, W.15968, it appears that Joseph VanDeBogart, while a resident of Schenectady, Schenectady County, New York, enlisted and served as a private in Captain Jellis J. Fonda's Company in Colonel Abraham Wemple's New York Regiment from July 1 to 21, 1777, from August 7 to 28, 1777, from September 19, to October 7, 1777, and from October 26 to November 2, 1781, amounting to at least sixty-three days in all.

He also served as sergeant in the Quartermaster General's Department in Captain Joseph Peek's New York Company from December 24, 1779, until December 24, 1780.

He married in July, 1778, in Schenectady, New York, Rachel Peterson.

He died, January 13, 1814.

His widow, Rachel, was allowed pension on her application executed July 15, 1837, at which time she was eighty-four years of age and was living in Schenectady, New York.

Their daughter, Eva, was baptized September 26, 1779.

There are no further data on file relative to family.
