

### **Pension Application for William Waldron**

R.11021 (Widow: Mary) Married April 5, 1781, he died April 8, 1824.

Letter in folder dated September 23, 1932, written in response to an inquiry.

Reference is made to your letter in which you request information in regard to John Tilton and William Waldron, soldiers of the War of the Revolution.

Revolutionary War data furnished by this office are obtained from claims made to the United States for pension and bounty land based upon the military service of soldiers in that war.

A search of the records fails to show such claims on file on account of the services of John Tilton as described by you.

The data which follow were obtain from the papers on file in pension claim, R.11021, based upon the Revolutionary War service of William Waldron.

William Waldron married April 5, 1781, Mary, the sister of Jerome Waldron.

William Waldron died April 8, 1824 in Romulus, Seneca County, New York.

The widow, Mary, applied for pension, September 1, 1842, then aged eighty-two years and living in Romulus, New York, and alleged that her husband, William Waldron entered the service on Long Island and was driven from there by the British and settled in Somerset or Hunterdon County, New Jersey and served in monthly tours and was in the battle of Monmouth.

The claim was not allowed as proof of service as required by the pension law was not furnished.

It is also stated in the claim that William Waldron was one of three brothers who were residing on Long Island and were driven from there by the British and settled in Somerset County, New Jersey. The names of his brothers were not stated.

The widow, Mary, died prior to November 3, 1852.

Their children were referred to, only names mentioned being-Samuel W. Waldron, who was fifty-eight years old in 1843 and living in Somerset County, New Jersey; and John W. Waldron, who was fifty-four years old in 1843 and made affidavit in Somerset County, New Jersey.

Jerome Waldron, brother of the widow, Mary Waldron, was eighty-two years old in 1842 and stated that he was born in Hunterdon County, New Jersey.
