

Pension Application for Daniel Ward

R.11127 (Widow: Susannah) April 2d, Married Daniel Ward Junr & Susanna Smith, 1778. Daniel died February 22, 1832. No deposition by Daniel Ward is in this file.

Susanna Ward of Pleasant Valley in the County and State aforesaid being first duly sworn according to Law doth on her oath, further say in order to obtain the benefit of the provisions of the Act of Congress passed July 4th 1836, in in act [blot] surviving Widows of Revolutionary Soldiers.

That her late husband Daniel Ward I understand when he first entered the service of the United States in the War of the Revolution as before stated he was attached to Captain Ostrams Company & in Colonel Frears Regiment. That he was in Captain Ostrams Company in the two engagements at or near White Plains in Westchester County in the year 1776.

That when the resignation of said Ostram, the said Daniel Ward Jur next attached himself to Captain Hatfield's Company & in said Frears Regiment & marched towards Pukeepsie [Poughkeepsie] or FishKill in said Dutchess County. That after said Hatfield deserted the service of the United States & went over to the enemy said Ward next attached himself to Captain John Straight Company & also in said Frear's Regiment. That after said Straight resigned the command of his company said Ward joined Captain Lemuel Conklin's Company & who in said Frears regiment. That this deponent does not now distinctly recollect any other officers under which said Ward served as heretofore stated in her pension declaration, than gave above stated.
