For the purpose of obtaining the benefit of "An Act for the relief of certain surviving officers and soldiers of the Army of the revolution" approved on the 15<sup>th</sup> of May 1828. I, William Webb of Dannsville [Dansville] in the County of Steuben and State of New York do hereby declare that I enlisted in the Continental line of the Army of the revolution, for and during the war and continued in its service until its termination, at which period I was a private in Captain [blank] company in the 2<sup>nd</sup> regiment of Artillery commanded by col. John Lamb.

And I also declare that I was entitled to the reward of eighty dollars under the resolve of Congress passed the 15<sup>th</sup> of May 1778—and I further declare that I as not on the fifteenth day of March 1828 on the pension list of the United States. (Signed) William Webb
