

### **Disability for John Whileber**

Dis—No Papers

Whileber, John

His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page 95.

Rank: Private

Regt: Col Morgan's

Disability: Wounded in the right thigh by a musket ball, but of little consequence.

When and where disabled: October 7, 1777, Behmus's Heights

Residence: Otsego

Remarks: not on the rolls of New York or Virginia.

Evidence transmitted by the District Court incomplete. Physicians certify the wound is of very little consequence.
