

Pension Application for Egbert D. Witt or Egbert DeWitt

On this 24th day of September 1832 before the Court of Common Pleas in & for said County personally appears Jacob J. Bevis of Sempronius in said County who being duly sworn says that he is well acquainted with Egbert Dewitt of Sempronius aforesaid and was well acquainted with him in the time of the Revolutionary War— That in the spring of the year 1782 the said Egbert Dewitt entered the service of the United States in the company commanded by Captain Andrew White in col. Wisenvelts Regiment and continued to serve in said company a term of nine months, that as a guard upon the frontiers in Ulster county that he was a soldier in said company but was engaged as an Indian spy during the most of said term and saw the said Dewitt frequently—that they then both resided in the town of Rochester in the County of Ulster and State of New York.
